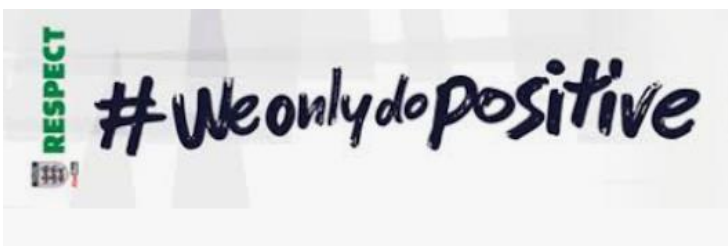
WHEN PLAYING SPORT AT NORTON FREE I WILL:

- Aim to have fun and enjoy playing sport
- Always try my best for the benefit of the team
- Play fairly and be friendly and supportive to other children
- Play by the rules and respect my friends, team-mates, the other team, the adult in charge, the referee, the teacher, my coach
- Shake hands with the other team and referee at the end of the game – win or lose
- Listen carefully and respond to what my teacher/coach tells me
- Understand that a teacher/coach has to do what is best for the team and not one individual player
- Encourage my friends/ team mates
- Respect the equipment/facilities that we use

I understand that if I do not follow the code, the following actions may be taken by my school:

I MAY:

- Be asked to apologise to whoever I have upset
- Receive a warning or a period reflection time from a member of staff
- Be required to miss a break or lunchtime activity or after school session
- Not be included in competitive activities and events with other schools
- Not be included in sporting activities permanently
