

Learn these facts to help you with your work:

Knowledge Organiser Year 1 Summer 2

Science

Children will learn to notice the signs of spring, what happens to the environment and how spring effects plants and trees. Children will learn what plants and trees need to grow and how to identify whether the tree is coniferous or deciduous. They will also learn a range of tree names and how to identify them based on their leaves.

vocabulary: Spring, new life, growing, Longer, Flowers, Seeds, water, soil, sunlight, grow, change, coniferous, deciduous.

PSHE

Children will learn why things change and how to cope with feelings around change. That human bodies change and that it is normal for bodies to change size and shape as they grow. Children will learn the difference between male and female bodies and how they have different parts. Children will learn which parts of the body are private and why they should be kept private.

DT Children will learn how to make healthy choices and learn new techniques such as chopping and spreading.

Music

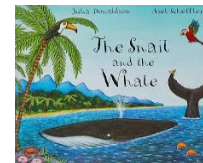
We will be revisiting songs and musical activities, a context for the History of Music and the beginnings of the Language of Music.
