Christmas crafts at Highfield Library

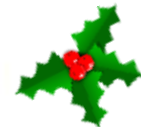
Drop in and get into the festive mood with some craft activities on the following dates:

This is suitable for children 6 years and over. Please note, we have limited table space so you may need to wait until space is available if busy

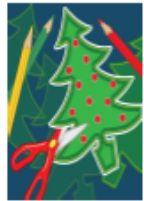
