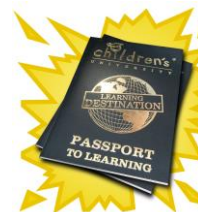


Passport Activity Newsletter

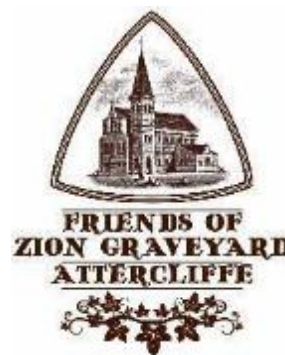
